**Under the agreement for 2015  
Mount Crosby State School will receive**

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the proportion of students in the upper two bands in Reading in Yr 3 from 47% to 50% in 2015.
- Increase the proportion of students in the upper two bands in Numeracy in Yr 3 from 32% to 35% in 2015.
- Increase the percentage of students in Yr 2 reading above Mount Crosby State School benchmark from 81% to 95% by the end of 2015.
- Increase the percentage of students in Yr 1 reading above Mount Crosby State School benchmark from 83% to 95% by the end of 2015.

## Our strategy will be to

- Continue the implementation of continuous assessment strategies to monitor student progress, provide feedback and inform teaching and learning.
- Embed the pedagogical framework to maximise student performance; Student centred planning; High expectations; Aligned curriculum and pedagogy; Explicit instruction; Evidence based decision making; Supportive school environment.
- Focus on early diagnosis and intervention.
- Engage parents early in the work being undertaken to support children with learning needs.
- Examine data for patterns to identify more proactive strategies that can be implemented.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Purchase resources as required	\$30,357
Engage specialist teachers to specifically work in Prep to Yr 3	\$30,000
Create an intervention coordinator position for each year level with planning time to support and monitor intervention	\$40,000
Provide additional teacher aide time to support learning needs for 35 weeks	\$52,000
Provide teacher release time (1 full day per term) to discuss and plan for individual student needs	\$44,280
Provide parent workshops to help build skill and knowledge	\$5,000
